SUB: Approval for constitution of Tender Evaluation Committee (TEC), as supportive committee to the Empowered Committee for the implementation of National Hydrology Project (NHP) – Reg.

PREAMBLE:

In the Government Order read at (1) above, Empowered Committee has been constituted for the timely implementation of the National Hydrology Project (NHP) and to achieve co-ordination of the various agencies and departments involved in the project, as per the guidelines issued by the Finance Department vide circular No.FD 27 PMU 1997 dated:13.03.1999 with the following powers:

- (i) Approve the works to be taken up under this National Hydrology Project.
- (ii) Sanction and award contracts regardless of their costs.
- (iii) Approve Extra Financial Implications upto 25% over the entrustment amount or Rs.10.00 crores, whichever is less.
- (iv) Engage consultants as per the project agreement with the World Bank.
- (v) Approve the requirements of staff to implement the project.
- (vi) Create posts for the duration of the project in accordance with the project agreements or to be filled up on contract.
- (vii) Procure vehicles, equipment, furniture and other supplies, consultancy services and procurement of Civil Works as provided in the Project Agreement.
- (viii) To constitute sub-committees such as Project Steering Committee, Tender Evaluation Committee as supportive Committees reporting to it, as and when required for the smooth implementation of the proposed project.
- (ix) Take any other decision for the smooth implementation of the project.
- (x) Review the progress of the project implementation and resolve any problem encountered during implementation.

The Chief Engineer, WRDO in the letter read at Ref-(2) has submitted the proposal to constitute Tender Evaluation Committee as per the powers delegated to Empowered Committee.

The Empowered Committee has accorded approval to constitute Tender Evaluation Committee (TEC) as supportive committee to the Empowered Committee for the implementation of National Hydrology Project.

Hence the following orders are issued for constitution of Tender Evaluation Committee ;


